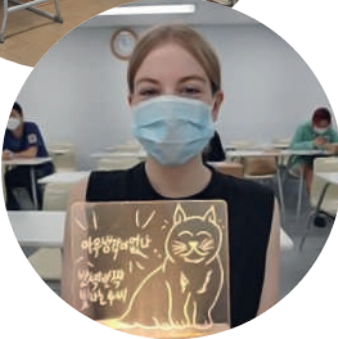
Customized cultural experiences according to the times and social trends

- Tuition fee KRW 1,650,000 won (Per semester)

- ※ D-4-1 applicants must register for more than 2 semesters.
- ※ Textbook fees (KRW 60,000~KRW 70,000 in each term) are excluded.
- ※ Application fee, tuition fee, and textbook fees are subject to change.
- ※ Even before the class starts, you cannot extend nor change the registered term, only cancellation is possible.
- ※ Payment difference may be caused by exchange rate for overseas remittance, and it will be settled after the class begins.

- The amount of refund will be in accordance with Article 23 of the Enforcement Decree of the Lifelong Education law.

(When you apply before classes start, you will receive 100% of the refund except the application fee.)

- ※ If you apply for refund, the D-4-1 visa from our Univ. will also be canceled.
- ※ Refund is only available by the account of the student's name.
- ※ If your account is an overseas account, you will only receive the amount which transferring fee is deducted, so please understand.
- ※ About four weeks to receive the refund. When it is an overseas account, it will take more than five weeks.

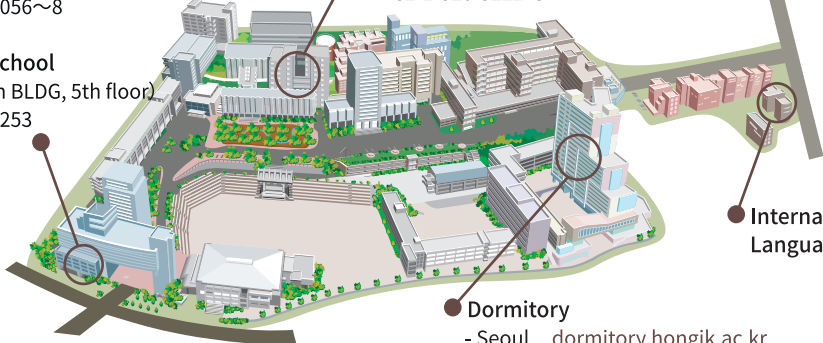

“Hello! My name is Maite, I’m from Argentina and I’m currently on level 4 of the Korean Language Program.

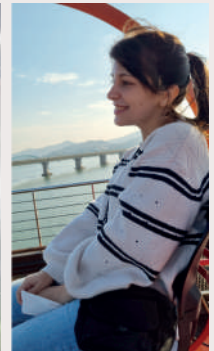

▶ To come from Sangsu station, Subway Line 6 (3min. walking)

Get off at Sangsu station on subway line 6 → From exit 2, walk straight for about 200m (3min. walking)
→ 'International language institute' is located on the left

▶ To come from Hongik Univ. Station, Subway Line 2 (20min. walking)

Get off at Hongik univ. station on subway line 2 → From exit 9 and walk straight for about 150m
→ Turn left at the crossroads and walk straight for about 350m until you find main entrance of Hongik university
→ Walk through the campus (Student union Bldg. → Liberal art C Bldg. → Dormitory)
→ 'International Language Institute' is located next to the post office

※ It is much more convenient to use Sangsu station since it takes more time to get to the institute through the campus from Hongik univ. station.
