#### A. Nationality recognition

- Foreigner means a person who does not have the nationality of the Republic of Korea.
- Multiple nationalities are not recognized as foreigners
- Both parents and students are recognized when acquiring foreign nationals before the start of the curriculum corresponding to the Korean high school curriculum.
- If parents and students renounce (lose) their Korean nationality, they must submit a certificate of loss of

nationality.

- If only one of the fathers or mothers is the obligor for support, only the nationality of the obligor for support is reflected (must be confirmed with government–issued documents)
- If there are any unusual circumstances related to family relations and nationality (divorce, remarriage, unmarried, death, disappearance, acquisition of Korean nationality, etc.), submit government-issued documents proving them.

#### B. Academic background recognition

- In principle, the period of study in elementary, middle and high school is based on the Korean education system.
- Grades 1 to 6 of the overseas curriculum are considered elementary schools, grades 7 to 9 are considered middle schools, and grades 10 to 12 are considered high schools (however, whether or not to recognize high school graduation from overseas high schools is based on the domestic regular high school system). Determined by comprehensively considering the school system and semester of each country)
- In the case of applicants from countries where the elementary, middle and high school education system is less than 12 years, the Minister of Education
   Only those who have completed all of the foreign curricula recognized as equivalent to the curricula are recognized as having the same qualifications as high school graduates.
- Among high school graduates who fail to obtain high school graduation qualifications before the date of admission to this school, acceptance (admission) will be cancelled.
- In the case of a (professional) bachelor's degree in China, an academic certificate issued by the Ministry of Education must be submitted.
- Domestic/overseas qualification exams, home schooling, cyber learning, etc. are not recognized as academic backgrounds as graduation qualifications or application qualifications.

#### 1. Documents related to academic background

- · For prospective graduates (completion)
  - Submit Apostille or consular certification of expected graduation (completion)
  - After graduation (completion) of the relevant school, additional final documents must be submitted by the day before the start of the school.
  - In case of non-submission, cancellation of admission and non-refundable tuition fee
- In the case of special reasons such as early graduation or skipping a class, it is mandatory to submit a confirmation from the relevant school or government agency
- 2. Identification card and family (relative) relationship proof documents
  - Parents' identification numbers must be accurately written.
  - · Record all changes within at least 6 months from the application deadline
  - · When parents divorce, submit divorce certificate
  - In case of death of parents, submit death certificate
- 3. Financial guarantee documents and proof of employment
  - Bank balance certificates, etc. must be issued on the form of the bank concerned, and the contact information of the bank must be written.
  - For domestic residents, only the original bank balance certificate issued by a Korean bank to an account in their name is accepted.
  - Institution, period of service, position, and contact information of the issuing department must be included.
  - Since it is checked by phone with the parent's institution, the exact contact information of the place of employment must be entered.

#### 4. Others

- All documents written in a foreign language other than Korean or English must be translated into Korean or English and notarized.
- If it is confirmed that you have passed through fraudulent methods such as forgery or falsification of submitted documents, lack of qualifications for application, or substitute examination (whether before or after admission), your acceptance and admission will be cancelled, and the paid tuition fee will not be refunded.
- · However, if it is not possible to submit the original within the application period due to unavoidable circumstances
  - A copy must be submitted first with permission from the International Relations Officer, but the original must be submitted within the designated period.
  - Admission may be canceled if the original is not submitted within the designated period or if the previously submitted copy does not match the original.
- Additional documents may be requested for document verification, etc.

### **Evaluation Criteria: Interview 100%**



- Document evaluation comprehensively evaluates all documents submitted by applicants.
- Applicants who do not submit documents within the application period or who do not meet the qualifications will be disqualified.
- Department of Music, Practical Practice for Interviews
- Those who do not attend the interview will be disqualified
- The interview is conducted in the designated test room on campus (in the case of overseas residents, video interviews are conducted).
- Applicants for the video interview will be contacted by the school on the designated date and time. (However, if we try to contact more than 3 times within 10 minutes, but cannot contact you, it will be disqualified)
- Screening grades and evaluation details are not disclosed.

- Under the consent of the applicant, we collect the minimum amount of personal information necessary for admissions (name, alien registration number, country of origin, address, school attended, contact information, guardian's name, etc.) not used for
- You cannot double-enroll in two or more colleges, universities, industrial colleges, and education colleges with the same entrance semester, and your admission will be canceled if the double registration prohibition is violated. In this case, the paid tuition fee will not be refunded.
- If the visa is not issued by the Immigration Office of the Ministry of Justice or a diplomatic mission abroad even for those who have been accepted (admission), the admission (admission) will be canceled and the paid tuition will be refunded in full.
- Applicants are solely responsible for visa refusal. If the visa is not issued within 2 weeks of the start of the semester without any special reason, admission may be cancelled.
- In accordance with the 「National Health Insurance Act」 and 「Enforcement Rules of the same Act」, from March
  1, 2021, foreign students will be automatically enrolled as local subscribers, and details such as insurance

### Map and Transportation







- D. Toward Namwon: Coreivera Hotel → Guest House → Jesus Hospital → Lee Donggyo Bridge → Jeonju University (takes 20 minutes)
