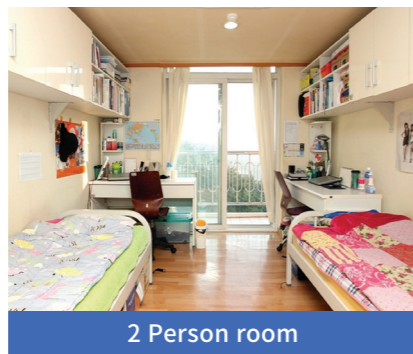

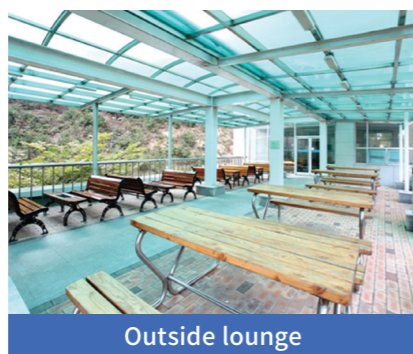

Eligibility Requirements (Undergraduate/ Graduate/ Korean Language Course)

- 01 Applicants are required to graduate high school. (Applicants for master's course are required to have bachelor's degree, and applicants for doctor's course are required to have master's degree.)
- 02 Applicants for undergraduate are required to submit TOPIK level 3 or above.
 - * Undergraduate students must acquire TOPIK level 4 or above by the end of Bachelor's course in order to graduate
- 03 Applicants for graduate school are required to submit TOPIK level 3 or higher.
- 04 Applicants must fit one of the three following common qualification to be eligible to apply.

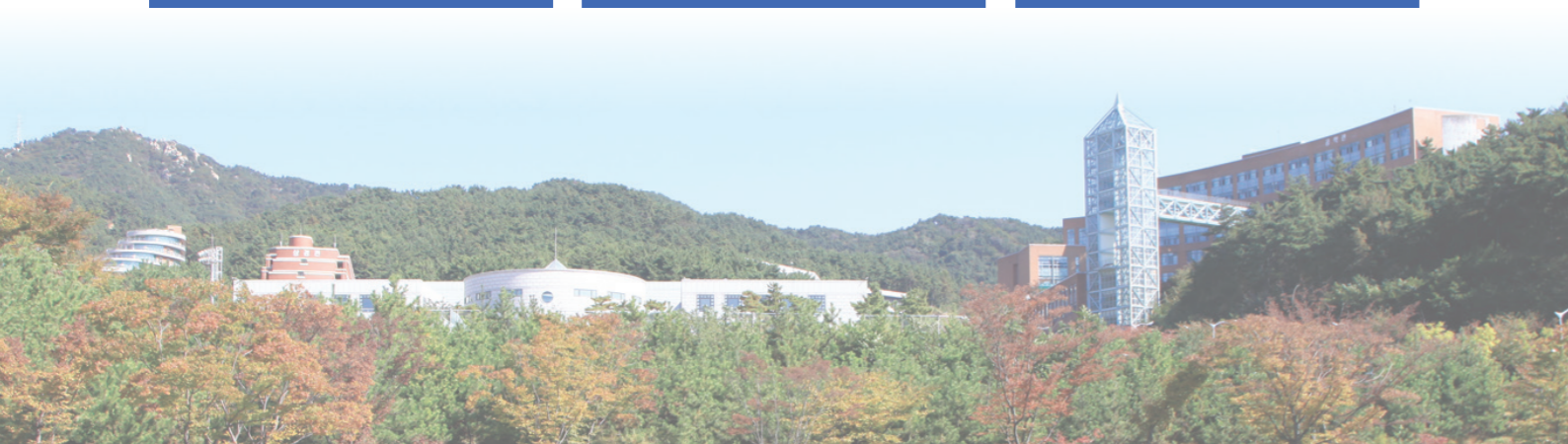

- 07 If at any point in the application process, any information or documents provided by the applicant is found to be false, application or entrance will be immediately canceled.

» Entrance procedures

- 01 Applicant should submit all required application documents to the Office of International Affairs before the deadline.
- 02 Screening of documents by Silla University.
- 03 Applicant will be notified of the screening results. Successful applicant has to deposit tuition to designated school account.
- 04 After confirming deposit of tuition, Silla University will send certificate of admission to applicant.
- 05 Applicant should apply for student visa via Korean embassy or consulate in applicant's country. (Guided by Korean Embassy)
- 06 Applicants should enter Korea after getting student visa within 90 days. Otherwise, the visa will be invalid.
