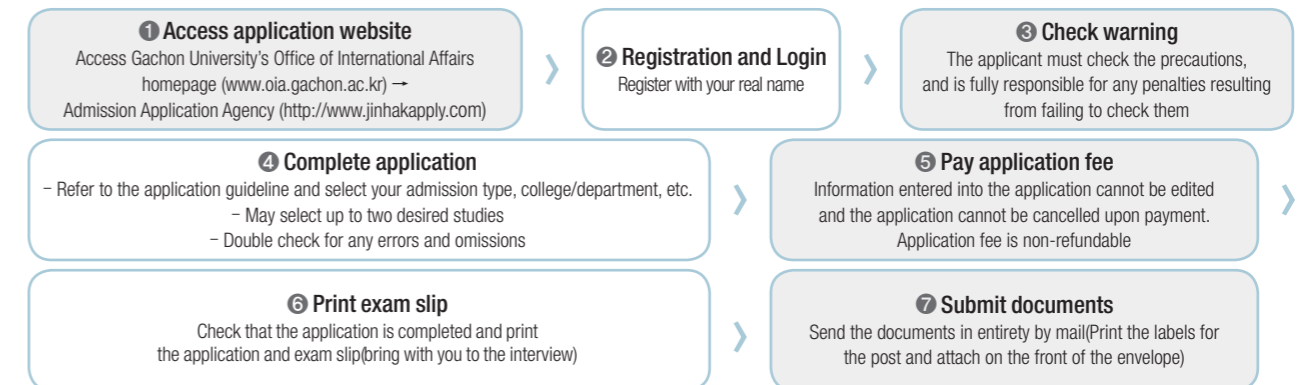
How to Apply

- For the application timeline and related documents, refer to Gachon University's Office of International Affairs homepage (<http://oia.gachon.ac.kr>) or the application guideline handbook
- The applicant is responsible for cancellation of acceptance due to a contact miss or an error in contact info entry on the application and cannot appeal for any reason.
- For documents having different names, the applicant must submit a certificate by the court of his or her country of citizenship, proving his or her identity

How to Apply Online

Please prepare an identification photo file (.jpg or .gif) to upload online

(The photo must have been taken in the past 3 months, must have a blank background, and must not be a snapshot)



- Admission applications are submitted online only and are not accepted in person

※ After submitting your application online, the original documents must be sent by mail or submitted in person

※ Personal information on the application must be identical to that in your passport

- You can check if your application has been submitted properly by your verification slip. You can also print other documents like your personal statement on the agency website

- You must fill in and submit your admission application and personal statement during the online application period and cannot edit them afterwards.

※ Our university keeps the applications confidential through the submission agency and does not use any personal information (name, alien registration number, passport number, contact information, etc.) for use other than the admissions process



Application Qualifications

New Enrollment

- Both parents hold a foreign citizenship
- Must have graduated or is planning to graduate from a high school that satisfies the Republic of Korea's first and secondary education curriculum, or must have an equivalent educational background to the above

College Transfer

2-year College Transfer

- Must satisfy all new enrollment qualifications. Must have graduated from a domestic/foreign junior college, or must have completed 2 years (4 semesters, summer and winter sessions excluded) and 32 credits at a domestic/foreign 4-year university.

3-year College Transfer

- Must satisfy all new enrollment qualifications. Must have graduated from a domestic/foreign junior college, or must have completed 2 years (4 semesters, summer and winter sessions excluded) and 65 credits at a domestic/foreign 4-year university.

Language Requirements for Both New and Transfer Enrollments

[Departments lectured in Korean]

- Must have a level 3 or higher in the official Test of Proficiency in Korean (Standard-TOPIK) or
- Must have completed the Gachon University Korean Language Center's Korean language course with a level 5 or higher, or
- Must have passed Gachon University's Korean Proficiency Test

[Departments lectured in English]

- Must have at least one of the following minimum scores: TOEFL 530 (CBT 197, iBT 71), IELTS 5.5, CEFR B2, TEPS 600
- * Students that hold citizenships in countries whose mother tongue or the official language is English can be exempt from the test score requirement by turning in documents proving the completion of secondary or higher education
- ** The Ministry of Education's standards of "procedure of language proficiency tests for international students" applied
